Organization

Growing from a desire to bring together collectors with an interest in Thailand, the Society was organized in 1977 by Gary A. Van Cott. The Society became affiliate number 78 of the American Philatelic Society in 1978. There are currently nearly 100 members worldwide.

Objectives

The Society strives to create a spirit of fraternity among collectors of philatelic material related to Thailand, to encourage research and study through the exchange of information and ideas, and to promote an interest in Thai philately.

Publications

The Society journal, **Thai Philately**, is published two or three times a year, in either cyber or printed format. It includes both specialized research and articles of general interest as well as related news. **Thai Philately** also includes news of Society activities, members, and meetings. All members are invited to take an active part in sharing their research and experience by contributing articles. A new Society member receives all back issues of **Thai Philately** for the current year.

Auctions

Seven Society auctions have been held. We try to hold at least one auction each year. All members are encouraged to participate, both as buyers and sellers.

Membership

All collectors with an interest in Thai stamps, covers, postal history, first day covers, revenues, and other related areas are invited to join the Society. Individuals who specialize in Thailand as well as general collectors wishing to learn more about this fascinating country are welcome. As a condition for membership, high ethical standards must be maintained by all members in all aspects of their philatelic life. 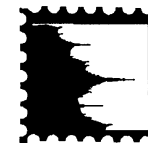

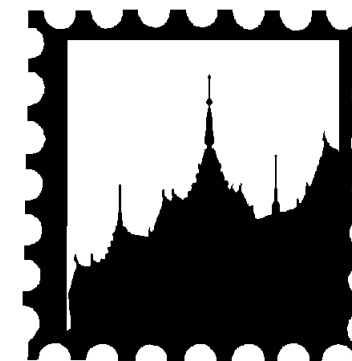
